

- 9.3. A statement from your program chairman or director endorsing the application from that program, including confirmation of the applicant's full-time registration in the program in both Fall and Winter terms of the academic year.
- 9.4. A 500-word statement which outlines your research project and its relevance to sustainable water resources. This statement should begin with a concise project title, and should focus on the research methods of the project. It should specify the type of data and analysis and state the expected outcomes (i.e. answer the question 'how?'). The project description should be reader-friendly to non-specialists and contain as little jargon as possible.
- 9.5. A completed application form.
10. How did you learn about the CWRA Scholarship?
11. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all material is sent to the Scholarship Committee in one package (other than references, and where appropriate, transcripts).
